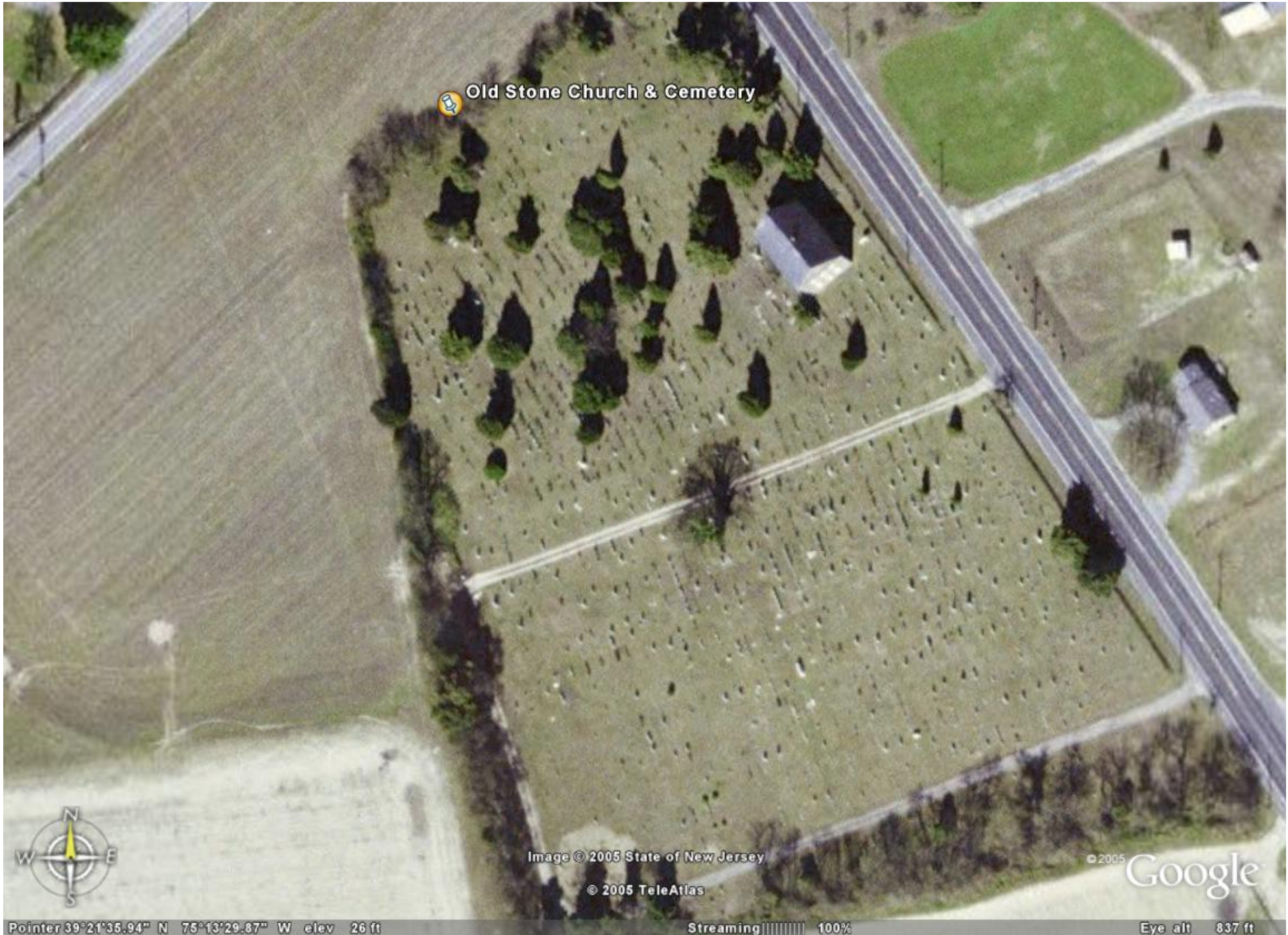


Locations of the Three Sites of Fairfield Presbyterian Church  
The current church building is located on 53 Main Street, Fairton.





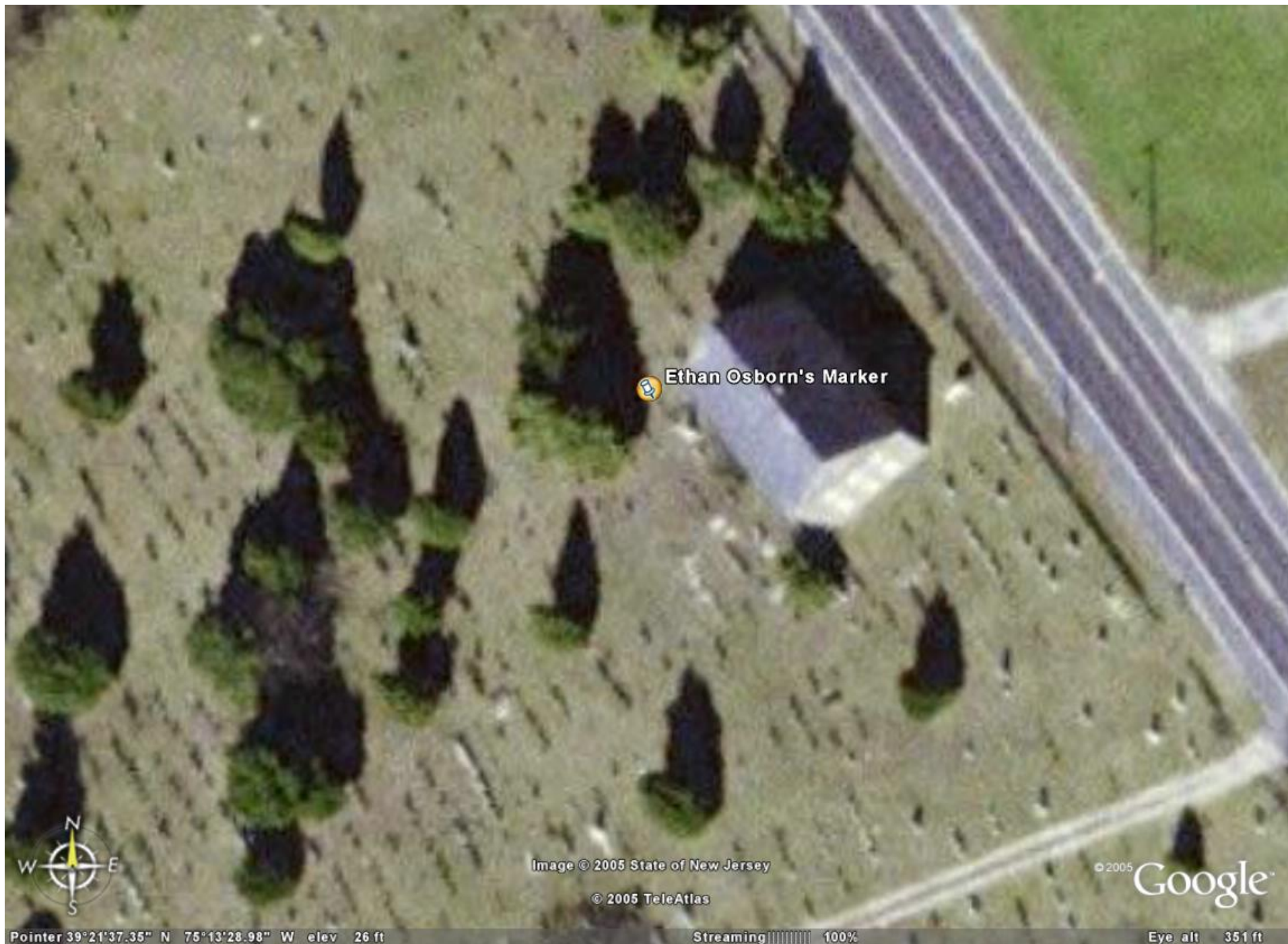

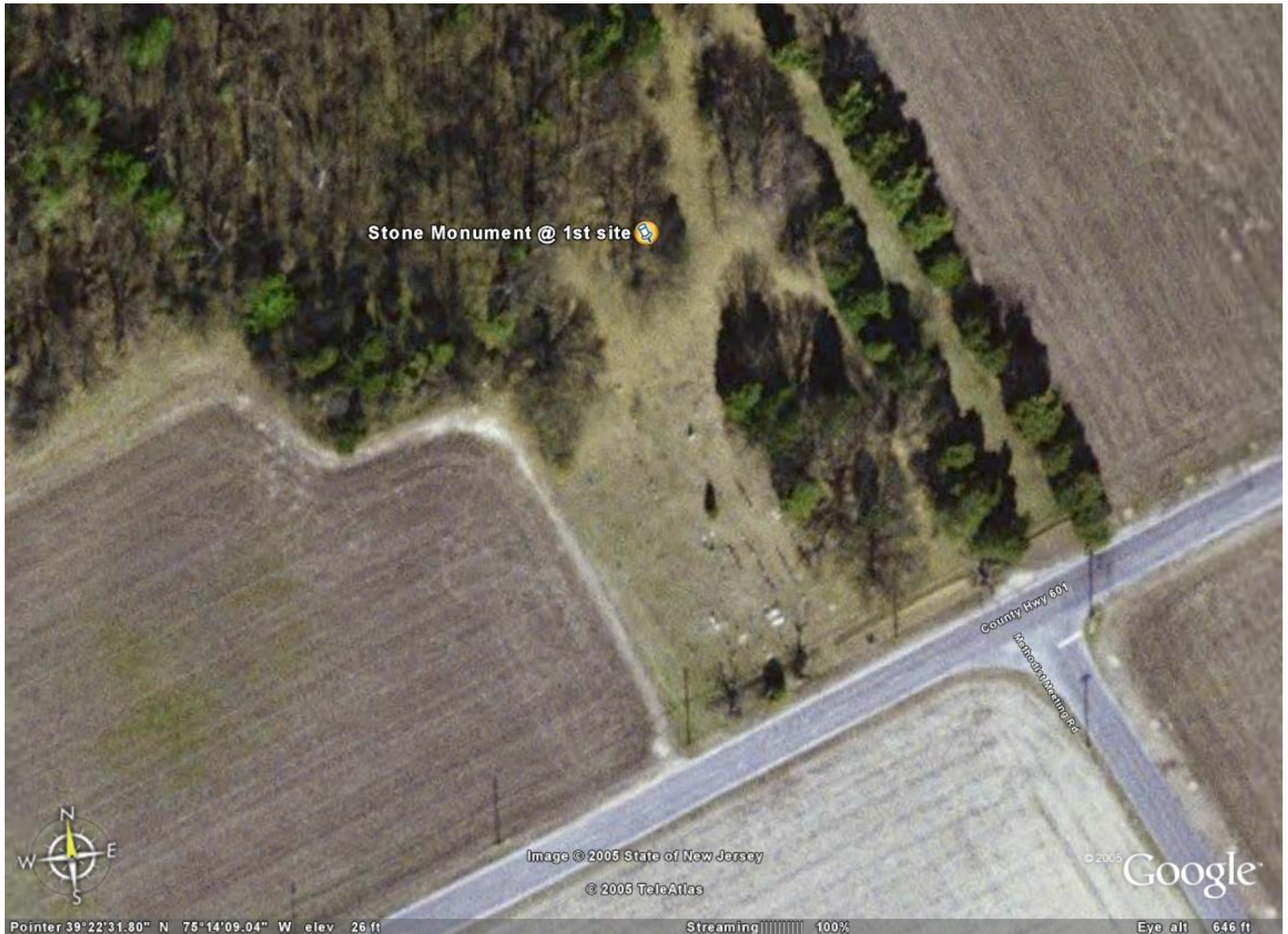
Old Stone Church & Cemetery

The Old Stone Church, built in 1780, was the third church building in use from 1780 – 1850.

This is the site for the first two church buildings. The stone monument is at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> column of trees from the right, just to the right of center at the top of the page. The Presbyterian cemetery is in the midst of the trees at the top center.
